LAST CHANCE HARVEY (12A) UK 2009. Dustin Hoffman and Emma Thompson's combined acting talents make them eminently watchable and infinitely attractive in this unusual love story featuring Harvey Shine, disappointed in life and love, and Kate Walker, a singleton making her own way. Described as a 'really nice' film, it's one to look forward to. Director: Joel Hopkins. 93 minutes.

SPECIAL EVENT: LA TRAVIATA, Verdi's opera full of melodious tunes, live from Royal Opera House.

KATYN (15) Poland 2008. Poland was in chaos. Its people fled, caught in a pincer movement between the Germans and the Russians, so there was no escape when the Soviets rounded up all their officers and massacred them in the forest of Katyn. Later they and the Germans, who'd also done dark deeds, played the blame game. The Polish women, left behind to carry on, maintained their dignity and resolve and kept alive their hopes for their men's survival. Directed by Andrzej Wajda and Oscar nominated for Best Foreign Language Film in 2008. Subtitled. 122 minutes.

LOOKING FOR ERIC (15) UK 2009. Eric the postman is slightly creased from a car accident, downhearted, divorced and struggling with two wayward teenage stepsons. The only shiny bits in his life are Man United, the materialisation of his idol, Eric Cantona, in his bedroom, and his mate, Meatballs. Broad comedy, a steady stream of wit and the emergence of a gangster sub-plot is unusual but very diverting fare from Director Ken Loach. The Cantona charisma is undimmed. 117 minutes.

SPARTACUS (PG) US 1960. The Romans trained Spartacus to kill for their pleasure, but they succeeded too well and he became a great gladiator and leader of men. He gathered fellow slaves around him and raised an ill-fated rebellion. This tale of the desperate fight for freedom is interwoven with the love story of Spartacus and the beautiful slave girl Varinia (Jean Simmons). Director: Stanley Kubrick. 197 minutes.

SPECIAL EVENT: SWAN LAKE, Tchaikovsky's classical ballet, pre-recorded by The Royal Ballet. Still time to book!

MARGARET MELLIS: A LIFE IN COLOUR (U) UK 2008. An important British artist, Margaret Mellis (1914-2009) lived and worked in Syleham from 1950 and Southwold from 1976 where she produced some of her most recognised works. Her career encompassed some of the major movements of 20th Century British Art, including the birth of the St Ives Group. She tells her own story for the first time on screen in this independently produced and creative documentary. We are delighted to welcome her son, Telfer Stokes, and the film's producer, Jules Hussey, to introduce this special screening.

SHADOWS IN THE SUN (12A) UK 2008. Jean Simmons, almost fifty years on from Spartacus, but still a consummate talent, stars as a feisty widow who loves poetry and her home on the Norfolk coast in this unexpected behaviour is no match for determination, amid the serene landscape, beautifully photographed by Milton Kam. An independent British film directed by David Rocksavage. 82 minutes.

MY SISTER'S KEEPER (12A) US 2008. Conceived as a bone marrow match for her sister who suffers from leukemia, Anna endures countless medical procedures to help keep Kate alive. Uncomplainingly she carries on and it is only when she reaches teenage that she begins to question the situation in which she is placed and to contemplate an almost unthinkable solution to her dilemma. Based on the book by Jodi Piccolt and directed by Nick Cassavetes. Starring Cameron Diaz, Jason Patric and Abigail Breslin. 106 minutes.

PUBLIC ENEMIES (Cert TBC) US 2009. John Dillinger (Johnny Depp), the charismatic and gung ho bank robber, was public enemy number one to J. Edgar Hoover's embryonic FBI and its top Agent, Melvin Purvis (Christian Bale). Wild chases and shootouts abound in this fast-moving action-thriller where one undoubtedly finds oneself on the side of the 'baddies', though the wily and ambitious Hoover will probably not be denied the ultimate victory. Director: Michael Mann. 143 minutes.

MATINEES: RACE TO WITCH MOUNTAIN (PG) US 2009. It's those Aliens again! what will we do if we ever find out there aren't any? Director: Andy Fickman. 98 minutes.

CORALINE (PG) US 2009: An 'other world' adventure, complete with a highly intelligent cat, a brave friend and a weird set of relatives. Director: Henry Selick. 100 minutes.

HANNAH MONTANNA, THE MOVIE (U) US 2009. Bound to wow the young ones who've almost certainly watched end-to-end Hannah on TV. Director: Peter Chelsom. 102 minutes.
